Mr. Barry Nathan Woodard, age 83, of Buffalo Valley, TN, passed away on Thursday, December 19, 2024.

Mr. Woodard was born March 1, 1941 in Hartsville, TN, a son of the late Leslie F. Woodard and Johna Pearl Franklin. He married Joyce Ann Bennett on July 9, 1962 and she preceded him in death on May 15, 2010. He was also preceded in death by Half Brother; Kendale Gross Nixon. Mr. Woodard served his country in the U.S. Army from August 2, 1966 until July 22, 1968, obtaining the rank of sergeant.
