Mr. Elmer Richard Maynard, Age 97 of Lebanon and formerly of Temperance Hall, TN., died Wednesday June 10, 2009 at Veterans Administration Hospital, Nashville, TN. Mr. Maynard was born October 7, 1911 in Lancaster, TN., the son of the late Mollie Jane Denney and James Everett Maynard.
