



## Freddie E. Poindexter

December 14, 1944 - February 22, 2008

Mrs. Freddie E. Poindexter, Age 63 of the Sykes Community, died Friday, February 22, 2008 at her residence. Mrs. Poindexter was born December 14, 1944 in Celina, Clay County, TN., the daughter of the late Una Eads and Fred C. Smith. An infant brother, James Smith preceded her in death. She was married to Franklin Gates Poindexter on September 23, 1961 in Celina. They moved to Smith County in August, 1975 and have made their home here since that time. She attended Celina High School and Lab Technicians School, working first at Celina Hospital and with Dr. Wiggins as a Lab Technician, then starting to work with the United States Postal Service, at the Carthage Post Office as a clerk and delivering the mail from December 2, 1978 to August 1987, Postmaster at Buffalo Valley from August 1987 to March 1990, Postmaster at the Old Baxter Post Office from November 1990 to August 1991, back to Buffalo Valley from August 1991 to March 1992 and Postmaster at the Brush Creek Post Office in March 1992 where she retired in January of 2008 after 29 years of service.
