Mrs. Irma Gwaltney Paschall, age 87 of Gordonsville passed away Thursday, November 6, 2014 at Quality Rehab and Health Center. Irma was born September 23, 1927 in Hickman, TN the daughter of the late Robert Bart Gwaltney and Edna McDonald Gwaltney. She was also preceded in death by her Husband; Earl Eugene "Pete" Paschall on August 12, 1968 and her Sister and Brother in Law; Doris and Wirt Lancaster. She graduated from Hickman Elementary School in 1940 and was a 1944 graduate of Gordonsville High School. She received her Bachelor's of Science Degree from Tennessee Technological University in 1962, a Master's Degree from George Peabody College for Teacher's in 1971, and an Educational Specialist Degree in Administration and Supervision from Tennessee Technological University in 1981. She began her teaching career in 1959 at Hickman Elementary School. She taught in the Gordonsville School System from 1960 to 1980 as both an Elementary and Special Education Teacher. She served the Smith County School System as Supervisor of Special Education/ Chapter 1 Director from 1980 until her retirement in 1991. She was a member of Delta Kappa Gamma Society International, having served as Secretary and President. She was also a Lifetime Member of the Gordonsville United Methodist Church where she taught Sunday School for over 35 years. She served as a County Commissioner from 1972 to 1978 and received the Smith County "Lady of the Year" Award in 1978. After her retirement, Mrs. Irma enjoyed traveling extensively throughout the world. Mrs. Paschall is survived by her Three
