Mrs. Janie Mai Vaden Bush, affectionately known as Ma Bush, age 89, of Agee's Branch in Gordonsville, TN, passed away Tuesday, August 16, 2016 at the Kindred Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Carthage, TN.

Mrs. Bush was born December 2, 1926 in the Helms Bend Community, the daughter of the late William Edgar and Vera Pearl Armistead Vaden. Mrs. Bush married Charles Bush on March 6, 1946 and he preceded her in death on September 28, 2000.
