



## Jimmy Charles Allmon

January 12, 1940 - May 29, 2020

Mr. Jimmy Charles Allmon, age 80, of Mt. Juliet, TN, and formerly a Smith County, TN, native died Friday, May 29, 2020 after his illness lasted over a 6 year period.

Jimmy was born January 12, 1940 in New Middleton, TN, to the late Auline Wills Allmon and Omar Allmon. He was also preceded in death by Sister and brother-in-law; Virginia and Donald Small, and step-daughter; Kelli Pitman. Jimmy was a 1958 graduate of Gordonsville High School. He went to work for Alladin Industries after he finished high school for several years. In 1977 he went to work for Servemotion and retired from there in 2003. He joined the U.S. Army in 1962. He was then transferred to the TN National Guard where he received honorable discharge in 1968. Jimmy was a charter member of the Chik-Fil-A Coffee Club in Mt. Juliet, TN.
