Mrs. Johnnie Sue Hogin, age 91, of Gallatin, TN passed away Saturday June 1, 2024 in Gallatin, TN.

Mrs. Hogin was born Johnnie Sue Wills on April 16, 1933 in Sykes, TN, to Johnny (Jack) Hatton Wills, who died on September 21, 1969 at the age of 65, and Altie Mai Webster Wills, who died on October 12, 1943 at the age of 37.

Mrs. Hogin graduated from Gordonsville High School in 1951 and attended Draughons Business College. She worked at First American Bank and retired from Sumner County Board of Education where she was the administrative assistant for the Transportation Department. She was married to Gerald Douglas Hogin, for 43 years, on December 24, 1953 and he preceded her in death on December 1, 1996. She was also preceded in death by an infant daughter, Katherine Sue Hogin in 1956: brothers L. D. Wills, Thomas Franklin Wills, Douglas MacArthur Wills; sisters: Dora Maude Daughtery, Bertha Mai Hunt, Margaret Louise Wills, Wanda Lavon Bluhm, Tillie Katherine Brunotts, Georgia T. Blair and many nieces and nephews. Mrs. Hogin was the last living sibling of her family.

Mrs. Hogin was a member of the First United Methodist Church of Hendersonville, TN for many years. She was a pillar of strength and independence, a dedicated Mom and Grandmother known as Nonnie.
