Mrs. Sarah Bullington Clark, age 36 of Alexandria, TN passed away Tuesday, August 19, 2014 from injuries received in an automobile accident. Sarah was born June 17, 1978 in Nashville, TN the daughter of James and Connie Mauzy Bullington. She was preceded in death by her Paternal Grandmother; Ellen Stevens. Paternal Grandfather; Walter Russell Bullington, and Maternal Grandmother; Jean Mauzy. She was a 1996 graduate of Gordonsville High School and later received her Master's Degree in Dental Hygiene from University of Tennessee at Memphis.
