Mrs. Syble McDonald Carter age 88 of Gordonsville died April 11, 2012 at Livingston Regional Medical Center in Livingston, TN. Mrs. Carter was born December 25, 1923, the daughter of Edgar Swain and Maggie Lee Lundy McDonald, one of six children; four girls and two boys.
